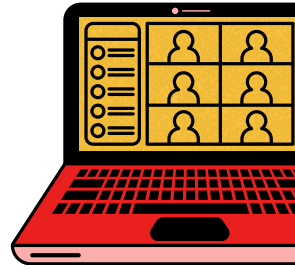

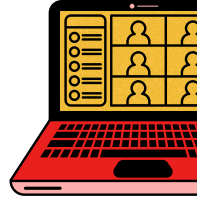

Applicant Eligibility:

Must be a high school student.

Must have completed at least the 10th grade by start of program.

Must be available for the 5-week program and commit to attending sessions during the week.

2 days a week - 12:30 PM to 4:30 PM PST (West Coast Teams) &

9:30 AM to 1:30 PM EST (East Coast Teams)

Students must have internet access and a computer for the program.

You will need to answer these short answer questions and submit a Brag Sheet/Resume:

What interests you in becoming a Health & Media Summer Scholar? (200-300 words)

What skills, perspectives, and background will you bring to the team? (200-300 words)

Is there anything else you would like us to know about you? (200-300 words)

A Brag Sheet/Resume - Tell us about your work, volunteer, leadership experience during your high school career. Feel free to highlight any content created like videos, mixtapes, memes. Work and volunteer experience can be participating in school sports, helping care for siblings, or helping parents with work etc. [Limit to 1 page]

It's best to complete the application in ONE-SITTING. If you close the page at some point it might not save your work. You will need to copy and paste responses onto the text boxes in the Short Answer & Brag Sheet section. Feel free to use Word to save your responses before copying and pasting on Google Form.
