New Campus FAQs

Questions	Answers
Are we changing our name to "Wiseburn High School"?	No. That is the name of the entire campus, which includes 3 high schools, 2 district offices and a community pool and gym. The name of our school is and will remain Da Vinci Communications.
On which floor will we be located?	We will be on the third floor of the building. DVD will be on the fourth floor, and DVS will be on the second floor. The first floor will house the theater, the music program, our FUTURES program, the Da Vinci Home Office and the Wiseburn District Office.
What time does school start and end?	Next year school will start at 8:50am, and end at 3:50pm. DVD will start/end 10 minutes after us, and DVS will start/end 10 minutes before us.
Will we have shared lunch with the other schools?	Our lunch will overlap a bit with DVD on most days, and will be separate from DVS unless we have a special schedule.
Will our classes change?	No, we will keep our three teacher teams for 9th and 10th grade, and continue running pathways like we do now for 11th and 12th grade.
Will we have more students at DVC next year?	Yes, with more space in the new building, our incoming freshman class will double to around 136 students. We will keep our small teaching teams and current class setup, and your classes and current grade cohorts will stay the same size.
Will we have the same seminar options next year?	Most seminars will be DVC only. There will be some shared seminars on the first floor or outside, including music and athletics.
Will the gym and pool be open?	The gym and pool will not open until sometime during Spring or Summer of 2018. Details of when students will have access has not yet been determined.
Will we be allowed to go to other schools' floors? Will students from other schools' floors be allowed to come to our floor?	Not without permission from an administrator.
Will there be parking for students?	Yes, but only around 30 spaces per school. Parking permits will be required, and applications for parking next year will come out after Spring break.
Where will we eat lunch?	Food will be served outside using the same vendor we use this year. Students can eat lunch outside or on our school floor.
Will we interact with teachers and administrators from other schools?	Probably not during the day, but but it is likely that you will see them before or after school, and possibly during lunch. They are all good people you can trust, and that you of course must respect and listen to just like any DVC teacher or staff member.
Will we have lockers?	No.
Will dress code change?	No, not for any school.
