It is your responsibility to continue to monitor communication from the colleges and ensure all required paperwork is submitted  Attend college campus open houses and local events for admitted students  Speak to family, college counselors, alumni, and your internal instincts as you think seriously about what college community is the right fit  Sign up for housing and make deposits for CSU colleges (at some campuses spots fill up quickly)
