Regulations Governing the Granting of Scholarships: Scholarships shall be awarded annually to female graduates of high schools in the South Bay area who plan to attend a four-year institution where National Panhellenic Conference sororities (NPC) are established. The Panhellenic Alumnae South Bay Association (PASBA) is a 501C3 non-profit corporation and does not discriminate on the basis of race, color, national and ethnic origin in the administration of its scholarship program. The PASBA scholarship is to encourage sorority membership among entering freshman women, however joining a sorority is not a requirement of this scholarship award. The scholarship award shall be for the 2023-2024 academic year. Scholarship Awards will be paid directly to Universities per NPC guidelines.

Qualifications: The applicant must be a resident of the South Bay. The applicant must meet the minimum scholarship requirement of a 3.5 unweighted grade point average, based on the 4.0 system. The applicant will be judged on the basis of academic excellence, character, participation in school and community/cultural activities, and financial need. *Applications must be received electronically or postmarked by March 24, 2023 at 11:59PM.*
