For Students Going to College in 2024-2025

Ready to invest in your future by attending university or a career technical college? Follow these steps to ensure you receive the max amount of aid you're eligible for!

☐ Figure out which application is right for you!

You only need to apply with ONE depending on certain qualifications: The Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) or the California Dream Act Application (CADAA).

Apply with <u>CADAA</u> if you:

- Are Undocumented (with or without DACA)
- Have a U-Visa
- Have Temporary Protected Status

Apply with <u>FAFSA</u> if you:

- Are a U.S. Citizen
- Are a Permanent Resident (Green Card)
- Are an eligible non-citizen

If you're the student:

- □ Student FSA ID/Login Info (for FAFSA only)
- □ Social Security Number (if applicable)
- ☐ Alien Registration Number (if applicable)
- □ 2022 Income Tax Return (if applicable)
- ☐ List of schools you're interested in attending

If you're the parent or contributor:

- □ Contributor FSA ID/Login Info (for FAFSA only)
- □ 2022 Income Tax Return
- ☐ Amount in checking & saving accounts
- ☐ Untaxed income such as child support received
- Assets like businesses, investments, real estate, etc. (Not including retirement or primary residence)
